

Mary Alice Watson Scholarship Fund

HGTC Alumni Association Scholarship Program

The Mary Alice Watson Scholarship Fund is awarded annually to a Heart of Georgia Technical College (HGTC) employee to continue his/her formal education.

The scholarship was established by Judith (Judy) R. Benton (former Board of Trustee member). Mary Alice Watson, Ed. D., began her employment in 1983 and was one of the first employees of this institution; she retired in 2003 as Vice President of Institutional Effectiveness.

The Mary Alice Watson Scholarship is \$500 to be awarded annually. The monetary stipend will be awarded by a check from the Heart of Georgia Technical College Foundation to the recipient upon successful registration and eligibility.* The HGTC Foundation is the fiscal agent for the Heart of Georgia Technical College Alumni Association.

A completed application and list of personal references are due by May 1 to the HGTC Alumni Association Coordinator. The award will be announced at the HGTC Alumni Annual Meeting which is traditionally held in June.

Eligibility Requirements

- Be a full-time instructor/staff; part-time staff of HGTC (minimum of 1 year)
- Submit proof of college registration documentation
- Write an essay on “How the *Mary Alice Scholarship Fund* would benefit my current position at HGTC”

A panel of judges will review the applications and name the scholarship recipient.

**The recipient of the scholarship will not be eligible to re-apply for at least three years.*
